Dead in Our Expectations 2 Kings 13:10-25, Pew Bible p. 320 January 21, 2024

I. When We Can't Expect God to Work (V. 10-13)

- A. We cannot expect God to work simply because He has worked in the <u>past</u>.
- B. We cannot expect God to work apart from a holy life in Him.

II. Why We Don't Expect God to Work (V. 14-19)

- A. We don't expect much of God because we can't tell the difference between God's promises and our <u>preferences</u>.
- B. We don't expect much of God because we're afraid of how much it will make us want to change.

III. How God Works When We Don't Expect (V 20-25)

- A. God rewards our faith, but He does not need our <u>permission</u> to work.
- B. God rewards our obedience, but His works are not dependent on our works.

Group Discussion Questions

- 1. Read 2 Kings 13:10-25.
- 2. Why do you think King Jehoash did not fully turn from idolatry, given the history of God's work in his family? Have you ever failed to appreciate the work of God in the past? What did that look like?
- 3. How can the great prophet Elisha die of a common illness? What does that tell us about God and His miracles?
- 4. How could King Joash be a wicked king and care so much about Elisha's death? Is it possible for someone to believe in God enough to fear for their wellbeing, but not enough to repent of their sin? Why?
- 5. What did Elisha see in Joash's heart when he only struck the ground three times, according to verse 19? Do you think it is possible for Christians today to settle for less than what God has promised? How and why?
- 6. What does God's work for Israel in verse 23 say about God's character in the face of faithless people? How does that give you hope in times when people don't expect much of God, including yourself?
- 7. Pray for our church members to prioritize our relationship with God over all other struggles of life. Come to the church prayer meeting this Wednesday from 6:00–6:30 pm in Worship Center Room 103.
