# Dead in Our Worship 2 Kings 16:10-20, Pew Bible p. 323 February 25, 2024

## I. The Beginning of Misplaced Worship (V. 10-11)

#### A. Misplaced worship happens when we put <u>anything</u> before God.

- 1. We worship what we <u>want</u> the most.
- 2. We worship what we can't stop <u>thinking</u> about.
- 3. We worship what we <u>love</u> with all our heart.

B. Misplaced worship happens when we are more impressed with <u>creation</u> than we are with the Creator.

1. There is a difference between reaching a lost world in order to save people and <u>impersonating</u> a lost world in order to impress people.

2. There is a difference between being saved and being <u>religious</u>.

# II. The Result of Misplaced Worship (V. 12-20)

A. Misplaced worship will turn even correct religious practice into pointless <u>nonsense</u>.

- 1. It stops you from being in <u>awe</u> of God.
- 2. It prevents you from being <u>convicted</u> of sin.
- B. Misplaced worship will <u>enslave</u> you, not free you.

## **Group Discussion Questions**

1. Read 2 Kings 16:10-20.

2. Have you ever been obsessed with something that was not God, as King Ahaz was in verse 10? What inspired your obsession and what did it do to your relationship with God?

3. What is the difference between liking something a lot and worshiping it? How do you know? Which do you think King Ahaz was doing with the Syrian altar in verses 12-16? How do you know?

4. What is the difference between reaching the lost world in order to save people and impersonating a lost world in order to impress people? Which do you think King Ahaz was doing? How do you know?

5. Was King Ahaz worshiping in the right place and doing the right offerings to God, according to verse 13? What does that tell you about the difference between being saved and being religious?

6. What does verse 18 say is the reason King Ahaz made modifications to the house of God? What does that tell you about how free we are apart from God? Is living a godless life true freedom? Why?

7. Pray for our church members to truly worship and avoid godless religion. Come to the church prayer meeting this Wednesday from 6:00–6:30 pm in Worship Center Room 103.
