# Strong Faith to Be Saved 2 Kings 19:1-19, Pew Bible p. 326 April 21, 2024

# I. Humanity's Need for Salvation (V. 1-7)

- A. There is no <u>self-help</u> for the human soul.
- B. Our only hope is in God's <u>intervention</u>.

### II. The World's Offense to Salvation (V. 8-13)

- A. The world is actively <u>denying</u> the works of God.
- B. Anyone who recognizes the works of God will become an <u>enemy</u> of the world.

### III. God's Plan of Salvation (V. 14-19)

- A. We must choose to believe in God's Word.
- B. We must specifically <u>ask</u> for salvation.
- C. We must desire to glorify God.

### **Group Discussion Questions**

- 1. Read 2 Kings 19:1-19.
- 2. Have you ever felt like you were failing at something God wanted you to do, as Hezekiah said in verse 3? What did you do about it and what was the result?
- 3. How do non-Christians react when Christians believe God is the cause of a certain event, according to verse 10? Have you ever chosen to believe God was at work and someone rebuked you for it? Why do you think your faith was so offensive in that moment?
- 4. What was the inspiration behind Hezekiah's rejection of Assyrian threats, according to verse 15?
- 5. What was Hezekiah's intended outcome to God saving him, according to verse 19? Why is it important to pray according to God's glory and not just our wishes?
- 6. What problem in your life do you feel is too large for you to fix? How can you pray like Hezekiah for God to save you in that situation?
- 7. Pray for our church members to have a strong faith to be saved from the tribulations of life and, most of all, from their sin. Come to the church prayer meeting this Wednesday from 6:00–6:30 pm in Worship Center Room 103.
