# Is God Angry with Evil? 2 Kings 21:1-9, Pew Bible p. 328 June 2, 2024

# I. The Nature of Man's Evil (V. 1-6)

- A. Evil is primarily a faith problem, not a works problem.
- B. Evil is <u>stupidity</u>, not wisdom.
  - 1. Evil never thinks.
  - 2. Evil never learns.
- C. Evil is ultimately a violation against <u>God</u>, not against people.

## II. The Impact of God's Warning (V. 7-9)

- A. God's warning to the world leaves everyone without <u>excuse</u>.
  - 1. His creation
  - 2. His story
  - 3. His Word
- B. We cannot <u>violate</u> God's world and keep God's blessings.

### **Group Discussion Questions**

- 1. Read 2 Kings 21:1-9.
- 2. How much space do verses 1-6 spend on the gods Manasseh served, as opposed to conventional acts of immorality? What does that say about how God views evil?
- 3. If Manasseh really believed in these gods and his people were happy, is what he did really that evil? Why? Are people of other religions today doing wrong when they worship other gods? Or just when they do something that hurts someone else? How do you know?
- 4. Why does it matter so much that Manasseh's sin repeated and surpassed the sins of the nations who used to live in Israel (V. 2 & 9)? How bad is it when Christians today are as bad or worse than the unbelieving world around them? Why?
- 5. Why do you think verses 4 and 7 put so much emphasis on the Lord's name being put in His temple in Jerusalem? What does that have to do with what Manasseh was doing in God's temple?
- 6. What does verse 8 imply will happen to Manasseh and his people if they do not obey the Lord's commandments? What are some blessings Christians enjoy from God today? How would unrepentant sin put those blessings at risk?
- 7. Pray for our church members to fear evil and flee from it, that we may not be a poor witness to our community. Come to the church prayer meeting this Wednesday from 6:00–6:30 pm in Worship Center Room 103.
