I. The Wrath of God (V.10-14)

- A. The Wrath of God is NOT:
 - 1. Uncontrollable or irrational rage
 - 2. Vindictive bitterness
 - 3. God losing his temper
- B. God's wrath IS:
 - 1. When holiness meets sin
 - 2. When justice meets rebellion
 - 3. A vindication of the holiness of God

II. The Patience of God (V. 15-20)

- A. Do not confuse the patience of God with:
 - 1. Acceptance of sin
 - 2. Peace with God
- B. The Patience of God is:
 - 1. God's restraint against sin without granting approval of sin
 - 2. God's measured response to sin to allow for repentance

III. The Mercy of God in Chastisement (2 Chronicles 33:10-12)

- A. God showed the evil Menasseh mercy by punishment.
 - 1. Mercy is not kindness, though it may be kind.
 - 2. Mercy here is sending punishment to instill fear unto repentance.
 - 3. Mercy here is to break the stubborn heart and subdue the spirit.
- B. God showed non-Justice, not injustice.

IV. The Forgiveness of God (2 Chronicles 33:13-20)

- A. God is quick to forgive.
 - 1. Despite the severity of sin
 - 2. Despite the duration of sin
 - 3. Repentance must be genuine.
- B. Forgiveness is true peace.
 - 1. Peace with God
 - 2. Saved from Wrath
