

**Coming Back from Death**  
**2 Corinthians 5:1-10, Pew Bible p. 966**  
**September 25, 2022**

**I. Looking Forward to Heaven (V. 1-5)**

- A. Heaven reminds us that death is not as bad as we think.
- B. Heaven is an eternal reward for the Christian.
- C. Heaven is the only hope after death.
- D. Heaven is guaranteed with the presence of the Holy Spirit.

**II. Letting Go of This Life (V. 6-10)**

- A. Heaven reminds us that this life is not as great as we think.
  - 1. If you don't want what is in heaven, you are probably not going there.
  - 2. If you have no desire to worship God in this life, you will not suddenly start in the next.
- B. Heaven reminds us that obedience is worth it.
  - 1. If a guarantee of heaven does not make you fear God more, you have no guarantee.

## **Group Discussion Questions**

1. Read 2 Corinthians 5:1-10.
2. Have you ever been afraid of death? Why? What are some things that have made you less afraid and what are some things that make you still fear it?
3. What are some reasons Christians should not be afraid of death, according to verses 1-5?
4. What do these verses mean by “we” and why does that help us understand what this text is saying? Why is it important that we understand when the Bible is giving assurance of heaven and when it is not?
5. How does the Holy Spirit function as a deposit/guarantee that God is going to bring someone to heaven? What about the presence of the Holy Spirit prepares us for heaven?
6. How does the assurance of heaven later help encourage Christians now, according to verses 5-10? Has the promise of heaven ever encouraged you? How?
7. Does the fact that Christians are promised heaven mean they will not be held accountable at all for their shortcomings on judgment day, according to verses 9-10?
