

**Coming Back from Defilement**  
**2 Corinthians 6:14-7:1, Pew Bible p. 967**  
**October 16, 2022**

**I. What We Can't Do (V. 14-18)**

A. Defilement cannot make a Christian less saved, but it can make a Christian less whole.

B. For a Christian to be spiritually dependent on or sinfully influenced by a non-Christian relationship is defilement.

C. Clarification:

1. Not all unequally yoked relationships are voluntary.
2. Not all forms of non-Christian partnerships are unequally yoked.
3. Defilement is an observation not a value statement.

D. For a Christian to mix the presence of God with the desires of the world is defilement.

**II. You Are in Your Way (7:1)**

A. Coming back from defilement is a decision.

B. Coming back from defilement means fearing separation from God more than separation from our idols.

## **Group Discussion Questions**

1. Read 2 Corinthians 6:14-7:1.
2. What does it mean for a Christian to be “unequally yoked” with a non-Christian? Why would 7:1 use such a harsh like “defilement” to describe it? Are there other things that can defile a Christian? Why are they so harmful, according to verses 14-16?
3. Is this passage saying that every relationship between a Christian and non-Christian is defilement? How do you know? What is the difference between being unequally yoked with a non-Christian and being in a right relationship with a non-Christian?
4. What does the fact that God resides in the heart of every Christian have to do with who they partner with in life, according to verses 16-18?
5. Have you ever had to cleanse yourself of defilement as a Christian, as 7:1 commands? What was the defilement and what did you have to do to get rid of it?
6. What does holiness and the fear of God have to do with Christians cleansing themselves of defilements, according to 7:1?
7. Pray for our church members, that we would cleanse ourselves of every defilement and bring holiness to completion in the fear of God.
