

**Judging the Dispute**  
**1 Corinthians 6:1-8**  
**November 7, 2021**

**I. The Contradiction (V. 1-3)**

A. Depending on non-Christians to resolve Christian disputes is telling a lost world that Jesus doesn't save.

B. SO... Evil in the church must be confronted (Matthew 18:15-17).

**II. The Consequence (V. 4-8)**

A. Going to unbelievers for justice tells the lost world:

1. God's church has no authority.
2. God's church has no wisdom.
3. Therefore, God's son has no salvation.

B. Depending on non-Christians to resolve Christian disputes is telling a lost world that Jesus doesn't save.

1. BUT... The church is not God's only source of judgment (Romans 13:1-7).

## **Group Discussion Questions**

1. Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-8.
2. What are some sources of interpersonal conflict in the church?
3. How are Christians supposed to handle interpersonal conflict, rather than suing one another in open court?
4. If Christians choose to depend on non-Christians to resolve interpersonal conflict, what message does that send to the world? What price does scripture say we should be willing to pay to avoid sending that message according to verse 7?
5. Is suing each other the only way Christians can respond poorly to interpersonal conflict or does this have a broader application? Explain.
6. Is the Bible telling us that Christians can never go outside the church for justice? Consider going to Romans 13:1-7 for help. How does a Christian tell the difference between depending on nonbelievers for conflict and resisting the authorities in Romans 13?
7. Pray for our church, that we would have a healthy culture of church discipline and protect each other from interpersonal conflict.
