Group Discussion Questions

1. Read Isaiah 6:1-13.
2. What are some national or global crises going on now? How does the Lord being on His throne impact how you see those events?
3. Have you ever beheld God in an awesome way? How did that happen for you?
4. How can the whole earth be full of God's glory even with so much evil and uncertainty in it, as verse 3 says?
5. Have you ever had a time in your life when the presence of God made you feel overwhelmed by your sin, like Isaiah was in verse 5? Is it a good thing or a bad thing to be overcome by your own sin in the presence of God? Why?
6. What is the relationship between being redeemed for your sin by God, as Isaiah was in verse 7, and being called on mission by God, as Isaiah was shortly after in verse 8?
7. In what way does preaching the gospel make some people more hard-hearted than if they never heard, as verse 10 implies? If so, what is the point of preaching the truth to people who are only going to reject it and then get worse?
8. Pray for our church, that our members would be on mission among lost family and friends this holiday season. Consider coming to the next online prayer meeting on Sunday, December 19th.
