Group Discussion Questions

1. Read Colossians 1:15-23.
2. What do you think is the difference between being made in the image of God, which is what human beings are, and actually being the image of God, which is what Jesus is, according to verse 15? Why does that matter?
3. Why do you think the Bible is so adamant that Jesus be both Savior and Creator? To ask this another way, what does creation have to do with the cross?
4. What does Jesus being the head of the church say about the importance of the church in the Christian life? What are the dangers of a church forgetting about the real head of the church?
5. Have you ever in your life been hostile in mind toward God, as verse 21 says? Why do you think you were that way?
6. What are some ways people shift from the hope of the gospel, as verse 23 says? What does that look like?
7. If Colossians 1:15-23 were Jesus' resume as a Savior, what does that say about His certifications? What are some other saviors people have made up since creation? Why do you think people tend to invent saviors of their own making?
