## **Group Discussion Questions**

1. Read 1 Corinthians 2:1-5.
2. What do you think Paul means in verse 1 when he says he did not use “lofty speech” or “wisdom” when he taught the gospel. What would lofty speech or worldly wisdom look like today?
3. The Bible is vast and rich, the unbelieving world is large and complicated, and this world is big and dense. Can a mature Christian really get away with just being an expert in Jesus and Him crucified as Paul says in verse 2? What about everything else there is to know about the Bible and the world at large?
4. What is the difference between flaunting your sin and being honest about your weakness, as Paul writes in verse 3?
5. How are Christians supposed to demonstrate the Holy Spirit’s power if they are also being honest about their weaknesses and limitations? Wouldn’t that make people look down on them and God? How does God shine through human weakness, as Paul claims in verses 3-5?
